THIRD PLACE WILL RECEIVE A **\$10 CASH AWARD**

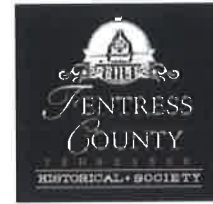

POSTER CONTEST

OFFICIAL RULES



1. Basic Information

Eligibility

The contest is open to Fentress County students currently enrolled in grades 6 through 12. The contest is not open to family members of the judges. No shared work is allowed.

Entry Limit

Two posters per student.

Entry Deadline

Entries must be submitted to Mike Wood, 500 North Main Street (Progressive Savings Bank), Jamestown, TN 38556, by 3 p.m. on Tuesday, April 25, 2017. Entries must be delivered by this date.

2. Poster Requirements

Theme

Posters must have a World War 1 theme. Please note that any posters containing brand-names will be ineligible. All subject matter must be in good taste.

Copy

Posters must contain any or all of the following words and/or phrases:

- "THE GREAT WAR"
- "Fentress County"

A credit line with the student's name will be allowed

Entry Form

The back of the poster must contain, in print, a legible copy of the:

- student's name
- student's phone number
- student's address
- student's grade level
- school name
- teacher's name
- teacher's email address

Poster Size

Poster can be horizontal or vertical, mounted on matte poster board (or foam core, etc.) and measure approximately 18" x 24"

Media

Any mixed media suitable for reproduction as a poster is allowed, including computer-generated graphics. Posters must be two-dimensional. All posters must be original art.

Winners

An independent panel of recognized representatives from the local art community will judge entries. These judges are selected at the sole discretion of the Fentress County Historical Society. The judges will not discuss the individual designs with the artists for any reason after the contest. Winners will be announced during the Spring History Roundup, April 28th, 2017.

Notwithstanding the foregoing amounts, the maximum sum that can be awarded to any one individual is \$50.00. In order to claim their prizes, winners must disclose their Social Security numbers to the Fentress County Historical Society. (for tax purposes)

All profits from any sale of the poster will go to the Fentress County Historical Society. The sole financial consideration for the artist is the prize. Posters may be displayed at the Fentress County Historical Society, reproduced in any official program and/or on the official Fentress County Historical Society website, fentresscountyhistoricalsociety.org, at the sole discretion of the Fentress County Historical Society.

3. Rights

All winning entries become the property of the Fentress County Historical Society. Other posters may be picked up from Mike Wood, 500 North Main Street (Progressive Savings Bank), Jamestown, TN 38556 between May 1 and May 30, 2017; weekdays only 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Posters left after 3 p.m. on June 1, 2017, will be destroyed. The Fentress County Historical Society is not responsible for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed posters.

Except as used by the Fentress County Historical Society, all artists, including winners, will retain the rights to their work. Entry in the contest constitutes full permission to publish names and photos of winners without further compensation. The determination of eligibility of entries and any interpretation of these rules is at the sole discretion of the Fentress County Historical Society and shall be final and binding upon all entrants.

By participating, the entrant agrees to abide by and be bound by these rules.
